Groovy Sweater (Dress)

Sizes: S (M, L)

Page 86:

Groovy Dress

DRESS (second column, fourth paragraph): Rnd 1: P1, m1, p2 (3, 4), work Bobble Vine Pattern across next 16 sts, p2 (3, 4) m1, p1, pm, purl across Back sts—Back: 22 (24, 26) sts, Front: 24 (26, 28) sts.

Page 88:

Best Friend Cardigan

MATERIALS: ... in French Grey or 332 (415, 415) yd of any super bulky weight yarn.

Page 89:

SLEEVES: Row 1: K2, *p2, k2; rep from * to end. Work 3 more rows in k2, p2 rib as established.

FINISHING: With RS facing, pick up 10 (11, 12) sts along Right Front Neck edge, 10 sts from holder, 10 (11, 12) sts along Left front Neck edge — 30 (32, 34) sts. (WS) Knit 1 row. Buttonhole Row: (RS) K2, yo, k2tog, k across. Knit 3 rows. Bind off loosely.

Page 91:

Karate Sweater

Materials: 6 (7, 8) hanks of Twinkle Handknits Soft Chunky ... in Clover

Notes from the Designer: A few words about sizes: Over the years, I've experimented a great deal with stitches, knitwear construction, and yarns—especially the chunky ones I love so much—to play with scale and create the silhouettes I want for garments. Many Twinkle knits feature a snug, body-shaping fit that looks fresh in big yarns. In some cases, proper fit means that the dimensions of the finished piece may seem smaller than you'd imagined. Therefore, if you're a size medium, follow the instructions for a size medium sweater even if the diagram measurements aren't what you expected. The sizing in the book is consistent based on how the garment is supposed to fit on the body. The finished garment measurements are not the person's body measurements. The general sizing standard of chest in the book is: XS = 31"–33"; S = 33"–35"; M = 35"–37"; L = 37"–39". For example, if you wear size small (or size 2 and 4) generally, regardless what the finished measurement is for that sweater, you should knit S size.

Pilot Hat

SPECIAL STITCHES:

C4L (Cable 4 left): Slip next 2 sts to cable needle and hold in front of work, k2; k2 from cable needle.

PILOT CABLE: Rnd 3: *C4L, p4; rep from *.

PILOT CABLE PATTERN ERRATA

= C4L

Page 96:

Chelsea Sweater

Materials: 9 (10, 11, 13) skeins of Twinkle Handknits Cruise in Tea Rose (A); 2 skeins in Back (B); 2 skeins in Mint (C) or 1560 yd of any DK weight yarn in the color of your choice

Gauge: With 4 strands of yarn held together: 8½ sts and 12½ rows = 5" (13cm) in pattern st on size 17 needles

CHELSEA STITCH: Row 1: K1, *k1...

BODY: ... Work in Chelsea Stitch until
22 rows are complete, end row 2.

RIGHT FRONT:... Note: There are a different number of stitches front [14 (17, 17, 20) sts] and back [9 (9, 11, 11) sts]. Work an occasional two front stitches together with a single Back stitch to ease in the difference.

SLEEVE: Row 2: ...for 26 more rows (for right Sleeve), for 27 more rows (for left Sleeve).

Cap Shaping: BO 6 sts at beg of next row—14 (17, 20, 23) sts...

Note: Both sleeve seams will be off-center, toward the back of the underarm. The schematic shows the right sleeve, the left sleeve should be its mirror image.

Page 101:

Balthazar Vest

Materials: 3 (3, 4, 4) hanks of Twinkle Handknits Soft Chunky ... in Sea Green

DIVIDE FOR NECK:

Row 1 (WS): Purl and cont working Right and Left Side Detail sts as established.

Row 2: Knit and cont working Right and Left Side Detail sts as established.


Row 3: Rep Row 1.

Row 4: K1, ssk, work to last 3 sts as est, k2tog, k1.

Continue as instructed in patter, but discontinue the Right and Left Side Detail patterns after they have been worked a total of 9 times (18 rows).

Page 102:

NECKBAND: ... Row 1: *K1, p1; rep from *. Work 5 more rows in k1, p1 rib as established...



Page 106: **Sexy Seaside Sweater**

Materials: 10 (11, 12, 14) balls of Twinkle Handknits Cruise (70% silk, 30% cotton; 120 yd/112 m per 50 gr ball) in Mint...

Page 109: Coco Jacket

Materials: ... 4 balls in Sun Flower (B) POCKET TRIM: With RS facing and crochet hook, join B to live sts of pocket. Work trim as for Lower Edging across 10 pocket sts. Sew each side of trim to body of garment.

Page 112:

Hamptons Halter

Materials: 8 (9, 10, 12) balls of Twinkle Handknits Cruise

Page 113:

LACY LEAF PATTERN: Rnd 10: K1, *k3...

Page 119:

Twiggy Tunic

Materials: 12 (14, 16, 18) balls of Twinkle Handknits Cruise

Gauge: Holding 4 strands together: 10 sts and 12 ½ rows = 4" (10cm) in reverse st st on size 15 (10mm) needles.

Notes: This sweater is worked holding 4 strands together throughout.

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Page 122:

Feather Scarf

Materials: 5 balls of Twinkle Handknits Cruise

Page 124:

Convertible Cardigan

BODY: ...Row 1 (right side): *K2, p2; rep from * across. Work 11 more rows smaller needle for edging. in k2, p2 rib as established.

Page 125:

DIVIDE BODY AND JOIN POCKET

... k36 (38, 40) Back sts, BO 4 sts, k2 (3, 4) sts, place next 12 pocket sts on holder and hold in front of work, k12 (A, B) CO 29 sts... sts from rem Upper pocket, k2.

JOIN SLEEVES (second paragraph)

Work even 4 rows. Next row (Dec Evening Shell Row): *Knit to 3 sts before marker...

NECK SHAPING AND BACK SHAPING Next Row: (right side) Knit 8 sts and place them on holder, knit to secondmarker, k1, ssk, knit to 3 sts before next marker, k2tog, knit to end. Next row: (wrong side) Purl 8 sts and place them on holder, work to end. Next Row: Knit 7 sts and place them on holder, work to end. Next row: Purl 7 sts and place them on holder, work to end, break yarn-34 (42, 50) sts rem. Place 15 sts of right front from holder back onto same needle.

NECK BAND: Row 1: (right side) Change to smaller needles, join new ball of yarn; p1, *k2, p2; rep from * across. Place 15 sts of left front from holder onto second needle and work in rib to end—64 (72, 80) sts. Work 37 more rows...

BUTTONHOLE BAND: Place markers on Right Front edge for 12 button holes...

Page 130:

Princess Capelet

Materials: 4 hanks Twinkle Handknits Soft Chunky

Page 134:

Marilyn Sweater

Use larger needle for body and

RIGHT AND LEFT FRONT PATTERN: Row 1: With B. knit.

Rows 5–8: With A, repeat Rows 1–4. **RIGHT FRONT:** With B, CO 10 sts... LEFT FRONT: With B, CO 10 sts...With B

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ARMHOLE AND NECK SHAPING: Right Back Shoulder: BO 2 sts, work seed st across next 5 (6, 7) sts, turn.

All sizes: BO 2 sts at beg of next row, work to end. Size L only: Work even 1 row, BO 1 st at beg of next row—3 (4, 4) sts. **All Sizes:** Work even 4 (4, 2)


NECKBAND: ...and side of Armband, CO 12 (12, 16) sts for shoulder... —84 (88, 96) sts.

Page 138:

Mohair Shrug

Gauge: Holding 2 strands together, 8 sts and 14 rows = 4" (10cm) in k2, p2 rib on size 17 needles

Note: Shrug is knit holding 2 strands together throughout.



Page 143: **Twinkle Hoodie**

LEFT FRONT POCKET (Third paragraph): Place markers as follows: Work 11 (12, 13) sts, place marker (pm) work 23 (25, 27) sts, pm, work 11 (12, 13) sts. Dec Row (RS): *Work to 2 sts before marker, dec 1, sl marker, dec 1; rep from * once, work to end—41 (45, 49) sts. Work even...

DIVIDE BODY (third paragraph): ... Rep dec row every 3rd row 4 (5, 6) times, end WS row—25 sts. Do not work Neck Shaping instructions.

HOOD: (RS) Inc 1 st at end of row— 26 sts. Place marker at Center Back. Work even... (last paragraph on page 144): ...—14 sts. Divide sts evenly onto 2 needles, BO using 3 needle BO method.

Page 145: **Aspen Hat**

Materials: US size 19 (12.75 mm) 16"

circular knitting needles

One set of US size 19 (12.75 mm) double pointed needles

Use size 19 dpn throughout if you can't find a 16" circular needle.

Materials: 5 (6, 6, 7) hanks of Twinkle Materials: 2 hanks Twinkle Handknits Handknits Soft Chunky in Pink

Left Front Cable Pattern: ROW 2 AND ALL WS ROWS: P2, k1, p4, k1, p2. ROW 6: P2, k1, p4, k1, p2.

✓ K2TOG

Third Column, First Paragraph: Next Row (Inc Row): ... -43 (47, 51, 55) sts. Rep Neck Dec Row every 6th row 1 (1, 0, 0) times and every 8th row 2 (2,

Divide for Armholes: ...place rem 11 (12, 13, 14) sts on holder for Underarm and Left Front. (You should now be one stitch before the marker on the Back).

Page 150:

Left Front: Place 11 (12, 13, 14) Underarm and Left Front sts on...

Page 151:

Magic Shawl

Materials: 5 hanks of Twinkle Handknits Soft Chunky in Icy Blue or White **Upper ribbing:** With smaller needles and WS facing, pick up and knit 50 sts from one long edge... Using larger needles and WS facing, pick up and knit 66 sts from the other long edge...

On right end of shawl, with smaller needles, pick up 38 sts.

Page 153:

Diamond Scarf

Soft Chunky in Lavender

US size 35 (19 mm) needles, or size to get gauge.

Page 154:

Shopping Tunic

Sizes: XS (S, M, L)

Materials: For solid version: 7 hanks Twinkle Handknits Soft Chunky in
