

Yarn spool pincushion

crochet pattern



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How to make a yarn spool pincushion

What you will need:

- Yarn spool coloured cotton yarn matching with crochet hook size 1,75 or 2
- yarn to wrap around your spool when it's finished
- crochet hook size 1,75 or 2
- needle
- pair of scissors
- stuffing
- 2 plastic rings, outside diameter 2,5 cm.



Some general instructions:

The pattern is worked in continuous rounds. Place a stitch marker at the beginning of each round.

Make your stitches not too loose.

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Abbreviations:

rep repeat

sc single crochet

dec decrease (use preferable a invisible decrease;

Insert the hook into the **front loop** of the first stitch (2 loops on hook). Insert the hook into the **front loop** of the next stitch (3 loops on hook). Yarn over and draw through the first two loops on the hook. (2 loops on hook). Yarn over and draw through both loops on the hook).

st(s) stitch(es)

Let's start!

Start with a magic ring

1 5 sc in magic ring (5sts)

2 2sc in each of sc (10 sts)

3 * 2sc in next st, 1 sc in next st, rep from* to end (15sts)

4 * 2sc in next st, 1 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st, rep from* to end (20sts)

5 * 2sc in next st, 1 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st, 1 sc in next st, rep from* to end (25sts)



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6 1sc in each st, **front loop** only! (25sts)



7 1sc in each st (25sts)

8 *dec over next 2 sts, 1sc in next st, 1sc in next st, 1 sc next st rep from * to end (20sts)

Now fit in a plastic ring



9 dec over next 2 sts, 1sc in next st, 1sc in next st, rep from * to end (15sts)

10 1sc in each st (15sts)

11 1sc in each st (15sts)

12 1sc in each st (15sts)

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Make two!

At one half you weave in the end of the yarn. Stuff the two half firmly.



Use the other end to sew the two halves together. Place them with the ends together, see picture below.



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Start sewing through both loops



Work your way around.

Before closing, at some stuffing.



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Choose a nice yarn to wrap around.
