You'll need;

Yarn; 6 skeins Drops, Flora, color 14 (1.8 oz – 50 g / 230 yards – 210 m)

Crochet hook; 3.5 mm / E

Gauge; Not important.

Measurements after blocking; Depending on the amount of rows you crochet

The measurements of the sample are; 21" / 53 cm wide and 84" / 210 cm long

Used terms and stitches (US)

ch – chain

ch-sp – chain space

ch2-sp - shows the number of chains in the chain space; in this case there are 2 chain.

sc – single crochet

dc – double crochet

st(s) – stitch(es)

rep – repeat

sk – skip

tc – turning chain

() repeat the instruction inside the brackets the number of times stated. This is also used where a number of stitches are all to be worked within a certain stitch or space, eg (tr, ch 2, tr) in next ch-sp.

[] Square brackets contain the stitch count at the end of the row.

***...; rep from * x more times** Repeat the instructions between the asterisk and semi-colon the number of times stated.

- When symbols come together at the bottom, they are crocheted together in one stitch, when they come together at the top, they are crocheted together.

Special stitches;

CL1 – double crochet 4 together; dc 1 on each of next 2 ch, but don't finish them, sk 1 ch, dc 1 on each of next 2 ch but don't finish them, now finish all 4 dc together

CL2 – double crochet 4 together; dc 1 half finished on ch3-sp, dc 1 half finished on sc, sk 1 ch, dc 1 half finished on sc, dc 1 half finished on ch3-sp. Then finish all these 4 dc together.

dc3tog – double crochet 3 together on ch1-sp

Chain 114,


Row 1; sk 1 ch, sc 2, ch 4, CL1, ch 4, *sc 1, ch 1, sk 1 ch, sc 1, ch 4, CL1, ch 4, rep from * 12 more times, sc 2, turn

Row 2; ch 3, dc 1 on 1st st, *ch 3, sc 1 on ch4-sp, ch 1, sk CL1, sc 1 on ch4-sp, ch 3, dc3tog on ch1-sp, rep from * 12 more times, ch 3, sc 1 on ch4-sp, ch 1, sk CL1, sc 1 on ch4-sp, ch 3, sk 1 sc, dc3tog on next sc, turn

Row 3; ; ch 1, sc 1 on 1st st, sc 1 on ch3-sp, ch 4, CL2, ch 4, *sc 1 on ch3-sp, ch 1, sk dc3tog, sc 1 on ch3-sp, ch 4, CL2, ch 4, rep from * 12 more times, sc 1 on ch3-sp, sc 1 on 3rd of tc, turn

Row 4; ch 3, dc 1 on 1st st, *ch 3, sc 1 on ch4-sp, ch 1, sk CL2, sc 1 on ch4-sp, ch 3, dc3tog on ch1-sp, rep from * 12 more times, ch 3, sc 1 on ch4-sp, ch 1, sk CL2, sc 1 on ch4-sp, ch 3, sk 1 sc, dc3tog on next sc, turn

Repeat row 3 – 4 until desired length of shawl.



Weave in ends and block the shawl.
